

Announcement for Postgraduate Studies At the Master's Level (MA/ MSc) 2018-2019

The Cyprus University of Technology accepts applications for a limited number of posts that will begin September 2018 in the following programmes:

Cyprus International Institute for the Environmental and Public Health

- MSc in Environmental Health
- MSc in Epidemiology and Biostatistics

Department of Multimedia and Graphic Arts

• MSc in Interaction Design (distance learning, in association with the Institute of Informatics of Tallinn University)

Language Centre

• MA in Computer Assisted Language Learning - CALL (distance learning, in association with the Department of Multimedia and Graphic Arts)

Study System and Attendance

For all master's programmes, attendance is continuous and mandatory and can be part time or full time. Classes are held in the afternoon and evening and the class schedule is structured so students that work are able to attend.

The following are required to obtain the Master's degree:

- Attendance according to the requirements of each programme
- Successful completion of 90-120 ECTS of post graduate classes and thesis for the Master, according to the program.
- Meeting other criteria, accordingly for each programme as described in their curriculum.

Fees

Tuition fees for all master's programs are €5,125 for EU students and €9,000 for non-EU students. When the applicant accepts the position, a deposit fee of €325, must be paid. This is a

Before the registration for each semester, the EU student must pay three installments of \pounds 1,600 for the remaining amount. However, tuition fees for the programmes offered by the Cyprus International Institute for Environmental and Public Health are \pounds 6,000 for EU students and \pounds 10,000 for non-EU students. Scholarships

The Cyprus University of Technology is able to grant internal scholarships for postgraduate studies on the basis of social-economic criteria, according to the Frame of the policy for Concession of Internal Scholarships for postgraduate studies, which is in effect at the Cyprus University of Technology. The Social Welfare Office accepts applications ONLY from applicants who have secured a position at a Master's programme.

Entry Requirements

Applicants must have an accredited University degree, awarded by an accredited institution in the country where it operates, or a degree evaluated as equivalent to University degree by the Cyprus Council for the Recognition of Higher Education Qualifications (KYSATS). Undergraduate students that are about to graduate can apply for a master's programme, considering that they expect to receive their University degree before the commencement of the master's programme.

Applications should be submitted electronically, by using the online application system of the University, Student Portal by the 31st of March 2018.

However late applications will be assessed depending on availability in each programme.

The following documents are required to be submitted, with the applications:

- A copy of a valid passport or Civil ID.
- A Curriculum Vitae (C.V.)
- Copies of University degrees or a confirmation letter which states that the candidate is expected to graduate before he starts the postgraduate programme.
- Copies of Academic Transcript
- A brief Personal Statement of goals and research interests (approximately 500 words) in which the candidate explains why he/she wishes to pursue a graduate programme at CUT
- Proof of English proficiency: Acceptable proofs of knowledge of the English language are G.C.E/ I.G.C.S.E exams, O level with a grade of at least C or ELTS/ IELTS with grade of at least 6.5 or TOEFL with grade of at least 580 (paper-based test)/82 (internet-based test).

Graduates of an English speaking University will not have to provide proof of English language knowledge.

- Any other certificates and documents, such as samples of relevant academic or professional work (publications, articles, portfolios etc.) according to the internal rules of graduate studies of the Department where the application is submitted.
- Reference letters are required only for the master's programmes of the Cyprus International Institute. In this case, the potential candidates are asked to provide the name of two referees who in a position to evaluate their academic and/or professional activities. Reference letters are sent electronically from the referees to the Studies Office at: <u>studies@cut.ac.cy</u>.

Application Evaluation

If the application is complete, with all the required documents, then the evaluation process is completed by the Graduate Committee of each department between 7-10 working days. The applicant will be able to see the status of their application from the Students Online Portal.
