

ANNOUNCEMENT FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDIES DOCTORAL LEVEL/GENERAL INFORMATION

The Cyprus University of Technology announces positions for postgraduate Doctoral level (PhD), with admissions starting January 2018 in specific programs that are posted online.

The application along with the supporting documents are submitted electronically, via the CUT portal starting from the following link:

The last date to apply for postgraduate studies is **Friday**, **17**th **of November 2017**.

In order for potential applicants to submit their application, they need to have a current email, and will be required to attach electronically the following:

- 1. Copy of identification card or Passport.
- 2. Copy of University degree and postgraduate degree Master level (where required). Or a document that verifies the applicant will finish their studies before the beginning of the doctoral program.
- 3. Transcript for the Undergraduate and Graduate degree/s.
- 4. CV
- 5. Short essay (about 500 words) describing the reasons for choosing the postgraduate program, research goals and the interests of the applicant.
- 6. Other documents and certificates such as sample academic work and professional work (publications, articles, surveys, digital work, etc.)
- **7.** A document noting the order of preference for the post or posts that the applicant is applying for as noted on the announcement for **Doctoral studies**

The potential candidates are asked to write on their application, the names of two people who will be able to be used as a reference for you about your academic and/or professional level. The Department may contact these people as references.

Every department can ask for additional confidential information from the potential candidate or chose to require specific criteria to be met to apply.

Study System

The doctoral programs are composed of at least 180 ECTS, where at least 60 ECTS relate to the comprehensive examination, for the preparation and presentation of the research proposal and the writing of a doctoral examination. The remaining workload relates to purely research of the project and any lessons that can be included in accordance with the Council's decision of the Department. Doctoral



students enroll each semester in one of the stages of the program. The requirements for a doctoral degree and other details regarding PhD studies are described in the Rules for Studies and Attendance.

Tuition Fees:

In accordance with the law, doctoral students pay tuition fees, the amount per program, without classes, with completion in minimal time of 3 years (for nationals of European Union) is ≤ 3.200 . In the case there are lessons, for each lesson there is a fee of ≤ 427 .

Please note that **applicants can apply for more than one thematic topic**. In this case, the applicant must attach a separate document noting the order of preference for the topics that they are applying for.
