

CUT LC scholarship for an online MA in CALL to EuroCALL members

Application Deadline

The deadline to apply is on the 7th of April, 2017.

The Language Centre of the Cyprus University of Technology is pleased to offer a half tuition scholarship to a EuroCALL member for the online MA in Computer Assisted Language Learning (CALL). The MA is offered for the academic year 2017-2018.

The MA in CALL is intended for language teachers from around the world, at all educational levels, who are seeking to attend a postgraduate programme in this area and in a mostly online mode. The MA offers knowledge and skills necessary for a professional career in teaching second / foreign language, assisted by new technologies, at all levels of education (pre-primary, primary, secondary, tertiary). The scholarship will cover half of the fees for a standard programme duration: Tuition fee of €2050 for European citizens and €3600 for Non-European Citizens

To be eligible to apply, candidates must have:

(a) A Bachelor's Degree

To meet the entry requirements for Master's level studies at CUT, students must be holders of a Bachelor's degree in an area related to language/ language teaching, from an internationally recognised university.

(b) English language Proficiency

Students must demonstrate proficiency in English through an internationally recognised test such as TOEFL, IELTS or equivalent. Required Test Scores: IELTS score of 6.5 or more; G.C.E/ I.G.C.S.E of C or better or TOEFL of 82 or better. In case a candidate has graduated from a Bachelor's programme offered in English, the English proficiency requirement will be waived.

Note: The scholarship will be granted based on the academic performance of the applicant.

How to apply

If you are interested in applying for the half tuition scholarship, you need to download and complete the following <u>form</u> and send it as an attachment to <u>macall@cut.ac.cy</u> by April 7th, 2017.

Master's Application Guide

Candidates must have a valid email address in order to apply and submit the following documents:

- 1. A copy of a valid passport or Civil ID
- 2. Curriculum vitae (CV)
- 3. Certified copies of all earned Degrees (or a confirmation stating that the candidate is expected to graduate before September 1st, 2016)
- 4. Certified copy of academic transcripts
- 5. A statement of interest (approximately 500 words) in which the candidate explains why he/she wishes to pursue the MA in CALL, as well as indicate specific areas of academic and research interests
- 6. Evidence of English proficiency (copies of certificates)
- 7. Any other certificates and documents, such as relevant academic or professional work (publications, articles, portfolio, etc.)
- 8. Two referees: include the names and contact details (email and telephone number) of two people who know your academic or professional background.
