Short bio: Polyxeni Potter was born and raised in Limassol, Cyprus. She went to the United States as a Fulbright Scholar to study in Ohio. She completed graduate work in Indiana and settled in Atlanta, where she taught English language and American Culture at Georgia State University for 10 years. Then she worked at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as science writer and editor and as Founding Managing Editor of the journal Emerging Infectious Diseases, where she pursued a global public health perspective and a multidisciplinary approach to science publishing.

Ms. Potter is a member of many professional organizations and has served on the board of several science journals, among them Science Editor and The African Journal of Laboratory Medicine. She has published hundreds of articles. Her book Art in Science was released by Oxford University Press in 2014.
