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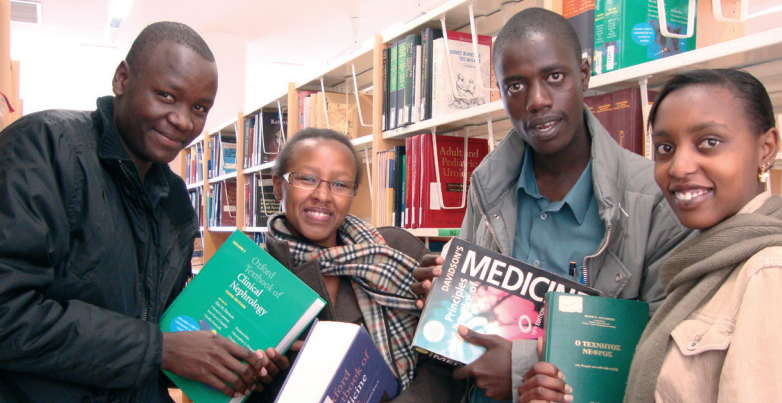

Greek Language Courses at the Language Centre

The Cyprus University of Technology Language Centre (CUT LC) offers Greek language courses of all levels to the wider public and to businesses. The courses follow the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (A1-C2). The courses are open to non- native speakers who are interested in learning or improving their knowledge of the Greek language. Courses aim at the simultaneous development of all language skills, namely reading, writing, listening, and speaking in authentic situations.

Programmes /Levels

A number of programmes run during the year, including programmes of general interest or specialised programmes, which are adjusted to the particular communicative needs

of the students. The particular features of these programmes (duration, level, cost, group or personal learning etc.) depend on the students' particular needs.

Greek for general purposes

These programmes focus on preparing students to communicate in various settings, such as social, friendly, etc., providing them with the necessary linguistic, cultural and digital skills and knowledge to communicate effectively, depending on the level. The material of the programmes for general purposes is authentic and is drawn from a variety of areas, such as: everyday life, market, history, customs, etc.

Greek for professional purposes

Each of these programmes focuses on the specific work environments and provides students with the necessary linguistic, cultural and digital skills and knowledge to communicate effectively in specific contexts. In order to achieve this goal, authentic material from the specific professional areas is being used. For example, there are Greek lessons for:

- Medical purposes (doctors, nurses, paramedical staff)
- Tourism professionals (customer service agents, pilot/ travel assistants, hotel managers)
- Legal professionals (lawyers, legal advisors)
- Embassies (consular officers, economic officers, visa support clerks)
- Shipping and foreign exchange professionals (financial officers, support clerks, secretarial staff)

Level

The programmes are designed according to the criteria set by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages:

- Basic Level (A1-A2)
- Intermediate Level (B1-B2)
- Advanced Level (C1-C2)

Activities

As part of the Greek language and culture teaching procedure, the students of the Language Centre of CUT are involved in various cultural activities such as:

- A. Visiting various places where authentic use of language occurs
- B. Watching Greek films with authentic use of the language
- C. Attending Greek theatrical performances and concerts

Certificate

- **Greek Language Knowledge Certificate:** The students who successfully pass the written and oral exams receive a certificate of Greek Language Knowledge.
- **Certificate of attendance:** Those who regularly attend the lessons receive a course certificate of attendance.

Registration

When: Beginning of each academic semester (September, January, May)

Duration of studies: 1 or 2 academic semesters, 13 weeks each, two 90-minute sessions per week

Teaching hours: Morning, afternoon, evening (depending on students' requests)

Tuition fees: 350 Euros

- The fees cover the entire period of study and include participation in the examinations of the same academic semester in order to obtain the Greek Language Knowledge Certificate.
- Student fees are paid in advance.
- Student fees will not be returned in case of discontinuation of studies or non-attendance of lessons.

Required Documents for Registration

- Step 3: Complete the payment of tuition fees
